## Annual Report for the year 2014-2015

**Agnesh Multipurpose development society** is a voluntary Organisation working for the empowerment of poor people, particularly villagers and backward community in rural areas of Ananthasagaram mandal for the past 1 years. This Organisation was established by a group of committed social workers in the year 2007 and has been taken up various developmental activities aimed to improve the living standards of its targeted beneficiaries by implementing socio-economic, educational and environmental programmes. During the year 2014-2015, the following activities undertaken by the organization.

### **Awareness on Swacha Bharath prog:**

Our organisation conducted awareness camps on Swacha Bharath programme, a prestigious programme of Our Prime Minister at Pathallapalli village of Nellore district. We distributed pamphlets on Importance of cleanliness in villages.

### **Water & sanitation Programme:**

Our organisation conducted awareness camps on importance of ground water and sanitation methods to be followed in Ananthasagaram village of Nellore district. We distributed pamphlets on Importance of Water. We constructed Drain canals for waste water

### **Welfare of Physically challenged:**

We conducted disabled welfare activities at Ananthasagaram mandal headquarters and surrounding villages. We conducted a medical programme for blind people and distributed medicines to the blind and physically handicapped people. We distributed tri-cycles to disabled persons. We conducted medical camps to mentally challenged children.

### **Pulse Polio Campaign:**

Our Organizers have actively participated in the Pulse Polio Immunization Campaign during January 2015 and February 2015 at our working area. They assisted the Government Officials to identify the eligible children and motivated their parents to immunize them. As a result, 100% immunization has taken place in our targeted area i.e Pathallapalli village.

### **Women & child care:**

This year Agnesh multipurpose dev: society has organized women & child care campaign in its targeted villages and educated women about using of medicines, raising of kitchen gardens to meet the balance of nutritious food and preservation of food in hygienic methods. Before starting this campaign we organized survey on health conditions of the people, particularly women and children and we identified malnutrition among the children. We commit ourselves to concentrate on mother, childcare during our camps, prepared necessary project proposals and submitted the same to Officials under Reproductive and childcare health scheme.

### **Vocation Tailoring Training Prog:**

Agnesh organized vocational training in Tailoring programme and in fashion designing in its targeted villages with the donation and trained poor women in the areas of Pathallapalli and Ananthasagaram villages, our organization trained 20 women beneficiaries and has achieved 100% result during the training period. Before starting this Programme, we organized a survey on abilities of the people, particularly poor destitute women.

### **Welfare of poor destitute women:**

This Organisation has started conducting training in preparation of readymade garments, Handicrafts, stitching of different dresses and handicrafts to women beneficiaries during this year. This Organisation had necessary infrastructure to provide training to rural women beneficiaries. This year we selected 18 beneficiaries in rural areas of Ananthasagaram Mandal for this programme. The Vocational Training Centre was established in Pathallapalli and conducted Training in Tailoring to the beneficiaries in two batches. We provided training to them for period of 6 months in the above trades for improving their employable skills.

**HIV/AIDS awareness programme:**

Our Organisation conducted training camps to 11 volunteers on AASA a programme on AIDS by the Government of Andhra Pradesh during November and December 2013. We trained total 18 volunteers in four seminars on AIDS. We attended a rally on AIDS on December 1<sup>st</sup>, World AIDS day at Nellore. We distributed medicines to HIV positive patients at Nellore AIDS rehabilitation centre. We distributed clothes to AIDS patients

**Awareness camps on Government programmes:**

Our organization conducted awareness camps on various Government sponsored programmes and about the Information act to the people of Pathallapalli village. We distributed pamphlets to invitees attended the meeting.
